



MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

International College of Graduate Studies,
University System of Taiwan
AND

Faculty of Arts and Social Science, University of Sydney

- 1. The purpose of this memorandum of understanding is to promote the educational and academic cooperation between International College of Graduate Studies, University System of Taiwan (herein referred to as UST) and Faculty of Arts and Social Science, University of Sydney (herein referred to as Partner). UST and Partner agree to try their best to achieve the following objectives:
 - (1) Promoting institutional exchange by inviting faculty and staff to participate in joint research projects;
 - (2) Promoting the exchange of essays, publications, theses, and information related to the research;
 - (3) Considering dual degree program;
 - (4) Promoting student exchange program.
- 2. In accordance with the principle of mutual and equal benefit, international travel costs will be borne by the visiting scholars (students), unless provided by specific arrangements.
- 3. Based on this MOU, UST and Partner agree to assist each other in drawing up and carrying out the concrete contents of the research project if they develop various education plans in different areas. Details of these plans will be set up in a separate addendum to this memorandum.
- 4. The MOU will be valid for five years; it will be valid once it is signed by the official representatives of the two institutes. If either party wants to terminate this agreement, written notice needs to be given to the other party six months before the termination of the agreement. However, the ongoing projects should be continued to the end and not be affected by the termination of the agreement.
