- 4. What is a "fully integrated poultry industry" according to J. D. Jewell's design?
- 5. In the 1950s, a struggle took place among efficient chicken farmers and inefficient chicken farmers, which resulted in a struggle for free market. Tell the story in a plain way, not using the original text.
